Can generate all popular types of barcodes from QR Code, Code 39, Code 128, UPC, GS1, GS-128, PDF417, Datamatrix to more exotic barcode types. Fully customizable fonts, colors, print sizes. Includes special functions to ensure output quality, and tools for adding barcodes to new or existing pdf files and images.

Fast application programming interfaces of ByteScout Barcode SDK for VB.NET plus the instruction and the code below will help you quickly learn how to set wide to narrow ratio. Just copy and paste the code into your VB.NET application's code and follow the instruction. Implementing VB.NET application typically includes multiple stages of the software development so even if the functionality works please test it with your data and the production environment.
