Supports QR Code, Code 39, Code 128, UPC, GS1, GS-128, PDF417, Datamatrix and many other barcode types. Includes various options for barcode generation to ensure output quality, add barcodes to new or existing pdf files and images. It can add barcodes to image in VBScript.

You will save a lot of time on writing and testing code as you may just take the VBScript code from ByteScout Barcode SDK for add barcodes to image below and use it in your application. In order to implement the functionality, you should copy and paste this code for VBScript below into your code editor with your app, compile and run your application. Use of ByteScout Barcode SDK in VBScript is also explained in the documentation included along with the product.

```
' Create barcode object and register it
Set barcode = CreateObject("Bytescout.BarCode.Barcode")
barcode.RegistrationName = "demo"
barcode.RegistrationKey = "demo"

' set symbology to PDF417
barcode.Symbology = 13 ' 13 = PDF417 symbology type

' set barcode value to encode
barcode.Value = "Sample barcode"

' Place barcode at bottom-right corner of the image
barcode.DrawToImage "..\wikipedia.png", -1, 400, 900, "result.png"

' Open the output file in default image viewer.
Set shell = CreateObject("WScript.Shell")
shell.Run "result.png", 1, false
Set shell = Nothing

Set barcode = Nothing
```
