On this page, you will find sample source codes which show you how to handle a complex task, such as, PDF splitting API in Java. ByteScout Cloud API Server was designed to assist PDF splitting API in Java. ByteScout Cloud API Server is the ready to deploy Web API Server that can be deployed in less than thirty minutes into your own in-house Windows server (no Internet connection is required to process data!) or into private cloud server. Can store data on in-house local server based storage or in Amazon AWS S3 bucket. Processing data solely on the server using built-in ByteScout powered engine, no cloud services are used to process your data!.

Use the code displayed below in your application to save a lot of time on writing and testing code. This Java sample code can be used by copying and pasting into your project. Once done, just compile your project and click Run. Writing Java application mostly includes various stages of the software development so even if the functionality works please check it with your data and the production environment.
