The sample source codes on this page shows how to extract text from PDF in VBScript. ByteScout PDF Extractor SDK can extract text from PDF. It can be used from VBScript. ByteScout PDF Extractor SDK is the SDK that helps developers to extract data from unstructured documents, pdf, images, scanned and electronic forms. Includes AI functions like automatic table detection, automatic table extraction and restructuring, text recognition and text restoration from pdf and scanned documents. Includes PDF to CSV, PDF to XML, PDF to JSON, PDF to searchable PDF functions as well as methods for low level data extraction.

You will save a lot of time on writing and testing code as you may just take the VBScript code from ByteScout PDF Extractor SDK for extract text from PDF below and use it in your application. Follow the instructions from the scratch to work and copy the VBScript code. Further enhancement of the code will make it more vigorous.

Trial version of ByteScout PDF Extractor SDK can be downloaded for free from our website. It also includes source code samples for VBScript and other programming languages.

VBScript - ExtractAllText.vbs

' Create Bytescout.PDFExtractor.TextExtractor object
Set extractor = CreateObject("Bytescout.PDFExtractor.TextExtractor")
extractor.RegistrationName = "demo"
extractor.RegistrationKey = "demo"

' Load sample PDF document
extractor.LoadDocumentFromFile("../..\sample1.pdf")

' Save extracted text to file
extractor.SaveTextToFile("result.txt")

' Open the output file in default associated application
Set shell = CreateObject("WScript.Shell")
shell.Run "result.txt", 1, false
Set shell = Nothing

Set extractor = Nothing
```
