' This example demonstrates how to add a video to PDF document.

' Create Bytescout.PDF.Document object
Set pdfDocument = CreateObject("Bytescout.PDF.Document")
pdfDocument.RegistrationName = "demo"
pdfDocument.RegistrationKey = "demo"

Set comHelpers = pdfDocument.ComHelpers

' Add page
Set page1 = comHelpers.CreatePage(comHelpers.PAPERFORMAT_A4)
pdfDocument.Pages.Add(page1)

' Add video annotation
Set movie = comHelpers.CreateMovie("sample.avi")
Set movieAnnotation = comHelpers.CreateMovieAnnotation((movie), 20, 20, 320, 240)
movieAnnotation.MovieActivation.ShowControls = True
page1.Annotations.Add(movieAnnotation)

' Save document to file
pdfDocument.Save("result.pdf")

' Open document in default PDF viewer app
Set shell = CreateObject("WScript.Shell")
shell.Run "result.pdf", 1, false
```
