It can be used from VBScript and VB6. ByteScout PDF SDK is the SDK for pdf documents generation, modification and updates. Can also generate and fill PDF forms. Provides support for text (fonts, style, size, font family), layers, pdf form fields, vector and raster drawings.

This rich sample source code in VBScript and VB6 for ByteScout PDF SDK includes the number of functions and options you should do calling the API to create submit form action in PDF. In order to implement the functionality, you should copy and paste this code for VBScript and VB6 below into your code editor with your app, compile and run your application. Use of ByteScout PDF SDK in VBScript and VB6 is also explained in the documentation included along with the product.

' Add page
Set page1 = comHelpers.CreatePage(comHelpers.PAPERFORMAT_A4)
pdfDocument.Pages.Add(page1)

' Create sample form
Set timesFont = comHelpers.CreateStandardFont(comHelpers.STANDARDFonts_TIMES, 14)
Set blackBrush = comHelpers.CreateSolidBrush(comHelpers.CreateColorGray(0))
