

How to extract text from pdf with pdf extractor sdk in VBScript and ByteScout PDF Suite

Continuous learning is a crucial part of computer science and this tutorial shows how to extract text from pdf with pdf extractor sdk in VBScript

The documentation is designed for a specific purpose to help you to apply the features on your side. ByteScout PDF Suite is the bundle that provides six different SDK libraries to work with PDF from generating rich PDF reports to extracting data from PDF documents and converting them to HTML. This bundle includes PDF (Generator) SDK, PDF Renderer SDK, PDF Extractor SDK, PDF to HTML SDK, PDF Viewer SDK and PDF Generator SDK for Javascript. It can extract text from pdf with pdf extractor sdk in VBScript.

These VBScript code samples for VBScript guide developers to speed up coding of the application when using ByteScout PDF Suite. Just copy and paste the code into your VBScript application's code and follow the instructions. Applying VBScript application mostly includes various stages of the software development so even if the functionality works please test it with your data and the production environment.

' Create Bytescout.PDFExtractor.TextExtractor object
Set extractor = CreateObject("Bytescout.PDFExtractor.TextExtractor")
extractor.RegistrationName = "demo"
extractor.RegistrationKey = "demo"

' Load sample PDF document
extractor.LoadDocumentFromFile("../..\sample1.pdf")

' Save extracted text to file
extractor.SaveTextToFile("result.txt")

' Open the output file in default associated application
Set shell = CreateObject("WScript.Shell")
shell.Run "result.txt", 1, false
Set shell = Nothing

Set extractor = Nothing
```
