Set rotator = CreateObject("Bytescout.PDFExtractor.DocumentRotator")
rotator.RegistrationName = "demo"
rotator.RegistrationKey = "demo"

rotator.Rotate "..\..\sample1.pdf", "result.pdf", 0 ' 0 - rotate 90 deg, 1 - rotate 180

Set rotator = Nothing

WScript.Echo "Rotated document saved as 'result.pdf' file."
```
