' Create Bytescout.PDFRenderer.RasterRenderer object
Set renderer = CreateObject("Bytescout.PDFRenderer.RasterRenderer")

renderer.RegistrationName = "demo"
renderer.RegistrationKey = "demo"

' Load sample PDF document
renderer.LoadDocumentFromFile "../..../multipage.pdf"

' Render PDF document at 96 DPI - default PC display resolution
' To get higher quality output, set 200, 300 or more
Dim renderingResolution
renderingResolution = 96

' Image format: 0 - BMP; 1 - JPEG; 2 - PNG; 3 - TIFF; 4 - GIF
Dim outputImageFormat
outputImageFormat = 1

' Iterate through pages
For pageIndex = 0 To renderer.GetPageCount() - 1
    ' Render document page to JPEG image file
    renderer.Save "page" & CStr(pageIndex) & ".jpg", outputImageFormat, pageIndex,
Next
```
