Most popular formulas can be calculated and recalculated with Excel installed. You may import or export data to and from CSV, XML, JSON as well as to and from databases, arrays and you can use it to remove rows from existing spreadsheet with VB.NET.

Fast application programming interfaces of ByteScout Spreadsheet SDK for VB.NET plus the instruction and the code below will help you quickly learn how to remove rows from existing spreadsheet. Just copy and paste the code into your VB.NET application's code and follow the instruction. You can use these VB.NET sample examples in one or many applications.

Trial version of ByteScout Spreadsheet SDK is available for free. Source code samples are included to help you with your VB.NET app.

        ' remove output file if already exists
        If File.Exists("Output.xls") Then
            File.Delete("Output.xls")
        End If

        document.SaveAs("Output.xls")

        ' Close Spreadsheet
        document.Close()

        ' open in default spreadsheets viewer/editor
        Process.Start("Output.xls")
    End Sub
