How to convert web page to PDF from link for HTML to PDF API in cURL: How To Tutorial

On this page you will learn from code samples for programming in cURL. PDF.co Web API was made to help with HTML to PDF API in cURL. PDF.co Web API is the Web API with a set of tools for documents manipulation, data conversion, data extraction, splitting and merging of documents. Includes image recognition, built-in OCR, barcode generation and barcode decoders to decode bar codes from scans, pictures and pdf.

You will save a lot of time on writing and testing code as you may just take the code below and use it in your application. This cURL sample code should be copied and pasted into your project. After doing this just compile your project and click Run. Code testing will allow the function to be tested and work properly with your data.

Trial version of ByteScout is available for free download from our website. This and other source code samples for cURL and other programming languages are available.

set QUERY="https://api.pdf.co/v1/pdf/convert/from/url?
name=%RESULT_FILE_NAME%&url=%SOURCE_URL%"

:: Perform request and save response to a file
%CURL% -# -X GET -H "x-api-key: %API_KEY%" %QUERY% >response.json
